

WHAT'S ON IN PREP ?

Term 3: September

The Preps have had another exciting month of learning. They are continuing to make great progress and are amazing us with their persistence, determination and achievements!

Literacy:-

In Reading, the Preps have been learning about Metacognition and Schema. They have considered their own unique thoughts, ideas, experiences, opinions and feelings and how they can connect these to the texts they are reading.

In Writing, the Preps have been learning about the writing traits: Ideas, Organisation, Voice and Word Choice. The students have particularly enjoyed learning songs to describe each trait.

Maths:

In Maths we have been learning about number and shapes. This has included subtraction, sharing, 2D and 3D shapes. The Preps enjoyed creating number stories to visually represent subtraction and sharing equations, and creating and describing 3D shapes using toothpicks and playdough.



Inquiry:-

The Preps have enjoyed studying different materials and their uses in the world around them. They experimented with building techniques as they recreated the story of 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff'. The Preps made an aluminium foil boat and a bridge, and thoroughly enjoyed creating a bindle out of their old pillowcase. They used 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' text to consider the importance of having a Growth Mindset and Bouncing Forward when mistakes are made.
