Literacy

In Reading, we are well and truly into reading our class novel—Hatchet. Hatchet is a great text for the students as the young character Brian deals with many different emotions and overcoming challenges. The Author, Gary Paulson, uses very specific word choices to explain the setting and the characters actions throughout the text. The themes allow students to challenge their thinking and assist in building understanding of the diversity in peoples lives.

In Writing, Hatchet has been extremely beneficial, in inspiring the students to be creative with their description of setting, character, feelings and emotion, problem. Students have used the text to develop their own multi genre texts, using a combination of genres such as fantasy, sci-fi, horror, poetry, comedy and action. During sharing time, we've been providing each other with insightful feedback on their writing to further influence their story.

Numeracy

In Number and Algebra, we have been revising our knowledge of number facts and how numbers are represented. We have improved upon our place value knowledge through playing online games (requested by the students) and looking into positive and negative numbers. Last week we also started an exciting project that relates directly to the school and increasing sustainability.

In Measurement and Geometry, we've looked at three dimensional shapes and what they are made up of, connected them to their nets and constructed some irregular three dimensional shapes. We have a good understanding of regular and irregular prisms especially finding the area and perimeter of these.

The mini project will be completed throughout the Term 3, as students prepare a proposal for the school to consider. We cant wait to see what is developed!
