• Late Arrivals & Early Departures : DEECD accountability practices insist that every child is marked on the roll each day, both morning and afternoon.

All children must be signed in by their parents and obtain a yellow "late arrival" card from the office before going to the classroom.

Children must also be signed out if they are departing early. Parents are required to inform office staff of their presence and sign the Early Departure sheet while office staff contact the classrooms.
