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

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From the Principal



Dear Parents & Guardians

The Prep and Grade One/Two students are leading the attendance race as they are tracking below 3 days per Term and well below the 12 day per student goal for the year. Well done! Grade 3/4 and 5/6 are doing well however both averages were above 3 days in Term 3. It is worth noting that on trend, some Grade 6 students will increase absenteeism in the latter part of Term 4. We encourage parents/guardians to continue to send students to school right up until the final day as, despite rumours to the contrary, we are teaching and learning for the entire term. It would be fantastic if we reach our goal of averaging 12 days or less.

We are very grateful to Caroline who is running a berry stall each Friday at assembly from 3:00- 4:00ish or until sold out. Carolyn is donating profits back to the school and hopes to raise \$1500. The strawberries are beautiful and we cannot wait until cherries and raspberries are in season. Caroline has set up for EFTPOS or cash payment.

Preparations are underway for our end of year family picnic with Christmas song presentations on the 11th of December. We hope that a more community-based approach to students experiencing performing in front of an audience will better suit families, and we look forward to seeing everyone. We anticipate that family picnics will commence from 5:30 with our first songs starting at 6:00 until 7:30pm, finishing with the arrival of Santa.

I would like to invite all families to a special assembly to be held on Friday the 9th of November at 2:45pm in remembrance of Armistice Day. A successful Federal grant application allowed us to develop a remembrance garden behind the flagpole and along with its official unveiling, a short ceremony will be held.

Paul Bailey and I recently attended a BARR (Bushfire At Risk School) information session and conducted a review of our Emergency Management Plan. Both fire and emergency incident drills are held each term and we appreciate the support we have been provided from the local CFA to ensure our preparation and response checklist is meeting all expectations. Work on reducing potential fire hazards is going to be carried out over the remainder of Term 4. In the event of a Code Red day where school closure has been enforced, notification to families is via Flexibuzz, phone call and notices sent home with students 3 days prior to closure. In the event of an unexpected incident resulting in closure, shutdown or delayed dismissal, a Flexibuzz notification will be sent in addition to a phone call. It is important that parents/guardians respect that in the event of an emergency incident which results in students to be collected from school, ONLY THE PARENTS/LEGAL GUARDIANS of a student are permitted to collect them.

We are very excited to welcome Mr and Mrs Saynor's baby boy Harry and Mr and Mrs Attrill's baby boy William. Everyone is doing well and as expected, they are besotted with the new additions to their families.

LATE PASSES AND ABSENCES –
