# WHAT'S ON IN GRADE 5/6


#### March 2018

## **Literacy**

This year we will be continuing with Reader's and Writer's Workshop. Our initial lessons were to establish protocols and expectations during these working times. We have begun revising all our reading strategies and how we are able to use them when reading.

In Writing, we have been studying features of Narrative writing and also developing characters when writing a Fantasy Narrative.



## **Numeracy**

Our time tables facts are an essential Mathematical understanding and we would like to encourage all students to continue revising and learning their times tables at home. We have learnt about square numbers and how we can represent them in an array. It was great to see that many students were taking risks with using a formula to find out the triangular numbers. Multiples and factors have also been a topic we have worked on.

In measurement and Geometry, we have created 3D shapes by using nets and our knowledge of faces, edges and vertices. Students were challenged in building their city using 3D shapes.
