Readers Workshop

Over the past couple of weeks, students have been focusing on:

Grade 1: Making Connections— students use their schema to relate what they read to personal experiences (text-to-self), to information from other text (text-to-text), and to information about the world (text-to-world) in order to enhance understanding.

Grade 2: Visualising and Synthesising—

Students have constructed mental images as they read a text by paying attention to the precise words the author has used. They have also been thinking about how their thinking grows and changes throughout a text.

Writers Workshop

The students are currently writing their Personal Narra-

tives as we dive deeper into strengthening their detailed descriptions of characters and settings. We look forward to completing the writing cycle this week so we can publish these stories for everyone to enjoy.



Next term, we will look at Persuasive and Informative writing.

Through closed and open-ended tasks the children have been exploring using their problem solving skills to solve real life maths problems.


We are also busy practising skip counting by 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's.
