Literacy

Students have enjoyed exploring our new mentor text, Let's Make Some Great Finger Print art by Marion Deuchars. We have investigated the amazing creations and presentation of the book, while learning about how to match our own writing with the audience and purpose. Students enjoyed asking questions of the author, particularly thinking about where her inspiration for the book may have developed. In Writing, we have been learning about Procedural texts and the importance of giving clear and specific instructions that follow a logical order. A great way to test this was by making our own finger print artworks. We look forward to seeing how creative students get when publishing their procedural writing.

Numeracy

We have been enhancing our knowledge and understanding of fractions along with how they connect to decimals and percentages. Students have loved relating their learning to chocolate bars, pizza and even bread sticks. We have also been challenging our thinking when finding equivalent fractions using multiplication and division. Students enjoyed learning about chance, discussing how events can be impacted by previous outcomes and determining if events are independent or dependent. Students are absolutely loving our inquiry unit this Term. They have been learning about different disabilities and the impact they can have on a person life.
