
# Term 4

### **Readers Workshop**

So far this Term, students have been exploring poetry. They have enjoyed reading poetry and

#### **Maths**

Strategies to help your child are:

**Addition/Subtraction:** Count on/Count back, number line, split strategy, vertical addition/subtraction.

Multiplication: Groups of, repeated addition, array.

**Division:** Sharing, repeated subtraction on a number line, array.
