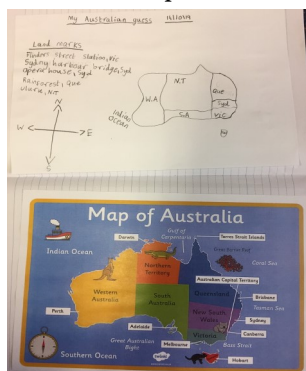
Grades 5 and 6

Term 4: My Country, My World

Prep

Students in Prep have begun the Term creating a 'Me on the Map' project. This Term they are using their geography skills and making a flip book of planets, continents, Australia, States and Cities within Australia, schools and their homes.

Grades 1 and 2

Grades 1 and 2 Students are learning how to successfully use an Atlas. They are also using their geography skills by mapping the Australian States and Territories and branching out more globally to the continents and world oceans.

Grades 3 and 4

Students in Grades 3 and 4 have started off this Term engaging in discussions and activities relating to the Australian language (including slang words), the Coat of Arms, as well as Tourism. Some key questions we compares and contrasted were: *What makes people want to travel? How and why do Australians travel? And why do people travel to Australia?*

Grades 5 and 6

Later in the Term, Students will begin a project relating to Tourism. In Grades 5 and 6 Students will create a book about Australian States and Territories. In Grades 5 and 6, Students will create brochures for their chosen country.
