Literacy

In Reading and Writing we have been getting stuck into the text Fox, by Margaret Wild and exploring her fantastic words, along with the rich illustrations from Ron Brooks. We've looked at this book from a number of different views and have delved deeply into the emotions, character traits and how they change throughout the text, and critically analysing different sections. We have decided that we can't judge a book by its cover, as it is much more intricate than what it looks on the outside.

By looking at this book in both Reading and Writing, we can analyse the Narrative layout and all the ups and downs that the characters experience, contributing to the overall storyline. We know that there is one major problem in the story, but when we look closely, we actually discover that there are heaps of problems and resolutions that build to enhance the overall text. From a writing perspective, we know that this is a model of how our writing should look and can use it as inspiration.

We will be looking at Narratives until the end of the term, then next term, diving into Persuasives.

Numeracy

We are working hard during Numeracy this Term!!

We've taken a slightly different approach to Numeracy this year, which has allowed students to be more independent in their learning and allow them to work towards completing a particular goal of their own. We have engaged in some self run projects which incorporates students using the computers to research and think about maths in the real life situations.
