

WHAT'S ON IN ART?

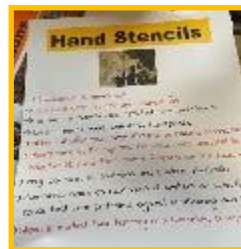
Term 1

- Indigenous Symbols



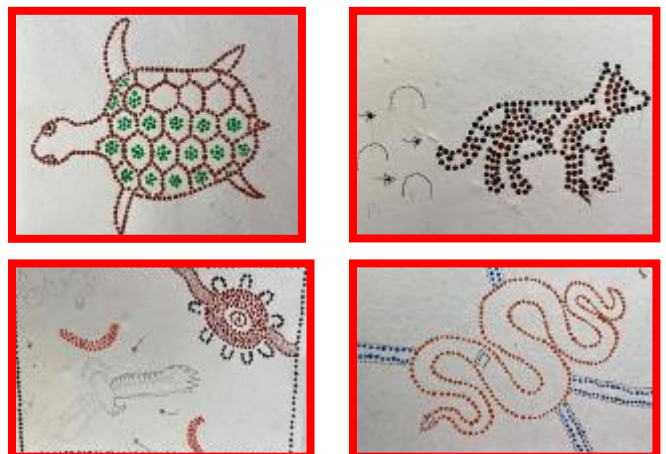
Grades 1/2: Hand Stencils & Dot Painting
