Noteworthy :

• **REMINDER TO PARENTS** :

* **Parents to park in marked parking spaces and walk their children to the gate** and students to walk into grounds independently.

* **Staggered drop off times** - Families with the Surname starting at A to K will be encouraged to drop off their child/ren at 8.45am. Families with the Surnames L to Z to drop off their child/ren at 9.00am. Rolls are to be marked at 9.15am.

* **Staggered pick-up times** - Families with the Surname starting at A to K will be encouraged to pick up their child/ren at 3.15pm and families with the Surnames L to Z to pick up their child/ren at 3.30pm. Staff will be out supervising the students to their designated exit gate.

- * Students in Prep M, Prep S, 1C, 1J, 5/6A, 5/6L and 5/6S will exit at the front gate.
- * Students in 1S, 2B, 2G, 2S, 3/4A, 3/4B, 3/4H and 3/4M will be exit at the east side gate.

* Siblings in multiple year levels - children will be picked up according to the youngest in the family. Eg : a family who has a child in Prep S and Grade 2G, the will exit from the front entrance gate.

* Parents/carers are to only enter the school grounds when essential to do so with prior notification and authority has been given from a staff member. Initial contact to the school is by phone or email where appropriate instead of face to face.

* Parents/carers do not to linger while picking up or dropping off children.

- **RETURNING ELECTRONIC DEVICES**: Families that have borrowed electronic devices (ipads, laptops, chargers etc) to use at home during remote learning are asked to return them with students next Monday, 12th October. These devices will be required at school for students to use for their classwork.
- GRADE 2 CAMP: At this stage, we are still waiting for confirmation from Gundiwindi Lodge and The Department of Education regarding the camp. If the grade 2 camp does go ahead, the dates are Monday 23rd to Wednesday 24th November.
- LUNCH ORDERS : Mr K's has advised that lunch orders are still in full swing for our students still to enjoy!
 Please ensure your lunch orders are given to your child's school teacher by 9.15am on each Tuesday for delivery on Thursday. We do apologise, but we cannot accept late lunch orders after this time.
