
WHAT'S ON IN ART?

They each created their own clay turtle complete with tissue paper habitat. Grade 3 and 4 students have created unique weavings and warped their own circular loom. Finally, Grade 5 and 6 students have been challenged to make their own hanging weaving complete with tassels and removing their creation from the loom for display.
