## From the Principal

Dear Parents & Guardians.

It is the start of December and it is hard to believe the end of another year is fast approaching and what a year it is has been.

We started 2020 with 38 Prep students and 15 grades without staggered drop off and pick up times, parents' onsite, whole school assemblies and no face masks. We just scraped in Harvest Market before the first lot of restrictions commenced. With the uncertainty around crowd sizes and checking and double checking of the incoming restrictions, the Harvest Market was again a success. As a community, we raised over \$29,000. An incredible effort! The profits went into the leasing of our netbooks, iPads and e-books.

Then remote and flexible learning came upon us and school as we had known changed rapidly. Students, parents and teachers had to learn how to use Google Classroom and Class Dojo very quickly. We loaned out a total of 121 devices to students to enable them to participate in the learning in the home. There was a number bumps throughout the transition to remote learning in Term 2 as we were all finding our way through unknown territory. Term 3 saw the introduction of live lessons and group conferences via Goggle Meet. The period of remote and flexible was a challenging time for students, parent and teachers. Students faced the challenges have not working face to face with their teachers, limited if any social interactions with their peers at school and local sporting teams. The role of care giver and educator was blurred for parents. For a number of our families this made remote learning quite difficult at home. We had families juggling working from home, families who had to take annual leave and families who had lost their jobs. Throughout the 2 stints of remote and flexible learning our staff were extremely grateful for the support that was shown through challenging times.

Throughout 2020 we have had major building and ground projects completed. We started with the sheltered area connected the Indonesian room and the Grade 2 portable and the veranda type shelter in front of Ms Bell and Mrs Smith's classroom. We now have sheltered areas in front of all classrooms to ensure students and parents are sheltered from the weather outside of their classroom. During our first lockdown we replaced the boundary fence. It was well over due with sections damaged from tree branches and gates that were broken.

Finally we had works completed to our shelter in place building which was completed by the Department of Education which included new fire proof decking boards, roller shutters on all windows and roof works to prevent ember damage. By the end of year we will have a new flag pole.

Art in Term 1, students increased their understanding of Indigenous Art. The Art Show looked very different this year with Ms Laird putting together a virtual Art Show to enable the students to show case their Term 1 pieces. The music program at Wandin North was sustained throughout 2020. We started the year with 2 school bands and students showcasing their talents in front of a big crowd at Harvest Market. Instrumental lessons continued virtually during lockdown. Our guitar and ukulele students participated in a virtual concert and our aim is to be back at The Grand Hotel in 2021 for our instrumental concert.

Thank you to all School Council members lead by our president Craig McEvoy, who have continued to support all of the school community through their commitment to council meetings and their interest in making Wandin North Primary School the best it can be now and into the future.

In 2021 we farewell Melissa Gardner and Caitlin DeKlijn who have chosen to take a new direction in their careers. We wish them all the very best for the year ahead. Ms Wilcox will be continuing in her role with the Department of Education in 2021. We welcome back Ms Burnage to full time teaching

Please keep to your allocated drop-off and pick-up locations in the interest of ensuring a COVID-19 safe environment.

- \* Parents/Carers are able to enter the school grounds only for the purpose to sign students in late or out early at the office. Please ensure you wear a mask inside and sanitise your hands before using the iPad.
  - \* Parents are to park in marked parking spaces and walk their children to the gate and students are to walk into grounds independently.
