

• ATTENDANCE: Due to changing over to Compass, our monthly attendance graph has been absent from our newsletters. Above is our average attendance per student for the Term. The State average for attendance is 12 days per year, which results in 3 days per Term. An absence includes students who are unwell, family holidays and parent choice. Unfortunately, we only have a 3/4 students with an average of 2.9 days that are tracking to meet the state average. I would like to remind parents that every minutes matters both academically and socially. It is challenging for children to maintain strong social connections when they are not present. Children can feel overwhelmed returning to school from extended periods of time away from the classroom, as there is pressure to catch up on the work that they have missed.

COMPASS - ABSENCE NOTIFICATIONS & EARLY DEPARTURES:
 Parents are asked to please ensure that the correct time frame is selected when sending absence notifications. Compass has two sessions: AM (9:00am – 12:00pm) and PM (12:30pm – 3:30pm).
 Please be careful with selecting the appropriate times for the length of your child's absence.

All students must be signed out the office using the Compass 'Kiosk' (iPad). Please see office staff who will arrange for students to be sent over to the Administration building for collection by parents/carers.

- NO NUTS PLEASE: Some children at this school are allergic to nuts. We urge you to refrain from sending food containing nuts to school.
- CAR PARK COURTESY: Parents are reminded to be patient and considerate of pedestrians and cars
 using the car parks at all times. Please park only in the marked spaces, adhere to the signs located in the
 carparks (no standing, disabled), refrain from double parking and blocking gateways.
 Reminder: Parking for 4WD's is available <u>beyond</u> the basketball court. Adults should always
 accompany children to and from parked cars.
