<u>What's on in 3/4?</u>

<u>Reading</u>



To begin the year, we have been revising and learning about all of our reading strategies while investigating the text 'What do you do with a chance?'. This has been a great text which has lead to

some wonderful conversations about having a Growth Mindset. This week we will begin studying the book 'The Stone Lion' by Margaret Wild. This is a book with a powerful message and we have been looking forward to sharing this book with the students all Term!

Students are working towards their personalised reading goals and it has been great to see the students developing their abilities to show and explain their thinking.



<u>Writing</u>

We began the year by revising the Writer's Traits and setting up our classroom community of writers. Students have been learning about different ways to plan narratives and they have been drafting their creative stories. We have worked on grabbing the reader's attention with bold beginnings and explored how to organise narratives using paragraphs. Students have been using their narrative rubrics to develop goals with their teacher to help them improve their writing skills.

<u>Numeracy</u>



We have covered many concepts this Term, but playing Chance games has been the biggest hit! Students have loved using their chance knowledge to compete

against their peers, as well as the teachers! We have worked on place value and students learnt more about addition and subtraction. In the upcoming weeks we are exploring fractions; involving the children in cooking at home is a great way to reinforce and develop concepts learnt at school!

<u>Inquiry</u>



In our inquiry unit, 'First Contact', we have been travelling back in time to the First Fleet and learning about what life was like for Indigenous Australians and the

convicts. Students have thoroughly enjoyed exploring different Dreamtime stories and are gaining a growing understanding of different language groups. We explored the size of the ships from the First Fleet and have begun to investigate what it was like for the convicts on the First Fleet.

<u>Google Classrooms</u>

All students now have their Google Classroom login. We have begun to work with this more within the classroom and are very proud of the Grade 4s for their mentorship and the Grade 3s for their concentration and persistence!

<u>Homework</u>
