Readers Workshop

Students have been continuing to learn about persuasive texts and reading our Mentor Text "The True Story of the Three Little Pigs"

Whilst reading this text, we have been focus- ing on the Synthesizing strategy. This strategy focuses on how a reader's thinking changes as they progress through a book.

Students show their thinking by using thinking stems such as:

At first I thought_____ but now I know_____

This allows students to reflect on past thinking and predictions whilst monitoring what happens in the text.

In the coming weeks, we will be looking at Information Reports and starting our new mentor text.

Writers Workshop

Over the past few of weeks, students have been immersed in our **Persuasive** unit and have been completing their persuasive letters. They identified their **audience** (Who they want to persuade) and their **purpose** (What they are trying to convince their audience to do) so they could write a letter to persuade their chosen person. They have been learning to form opinions, develop reasons and learnt about devises such as rhe-



torical questions, powerful verbs and writer's voice.

This week, we begin our immersion into information texts in preparation for researching and creating their animal poster. The student's visit to the zoo will help inspire them to choose an animal they'd love to learn more about.

Maths

Over the past 2 weeks, students have been working very hard to develop their knowledge and understanding of time.

Students learnt about telling the time using model clocks and being able to use language such as o'clock, half past and quarter to/quarter past.

Students are making connections with events that take place on the school day and identifying regular times that these events occur at.

Next week, we begin our unit on Patterns.
