ABSENCE NOTIFICATIONS - All absences from school must be entered via Compass, including non-attendance to excursions, sports, etc.

Parents are asked to please ensure that the correct time frame is selected when sending absence notifications. Compass has two sessions : AM (9:00am – 12:00pm) and PM (12:30pm – 3:30pm). Please be careful with selecting the appropriate times for the length of your child's absence.

LATE ARRIVALS & EARLY DEPARTURES - All students must be signed in and out at the office using the Compass 'Kiosk' (iPad). Late students need to obtain a 'Late Pass' upon arrival. Students being collected early will be called to the office by staff where they are to be collected by parents/carers.
