Dear Families,

As we look forward to having our final cohort of students, our Grade 3/4s, it has been great to have the buzz back in classrooms. There were plenty of smiles from teachers, students and parents as we welcomed our Prep, 1/2 and 5/6 cohorts back last week. This week will be our last of staggered returning of cohorts, parents having to fill out Google forms for onsite supervision and we will see all students returning to full time onsite schooling on Monday 1st of November.

Currently, we have Prep – 2 students dropped off and picked up from the Warburton Highway entrance and 3-6 students dropped off and picked up from the gravel car park until further notice.

With an increase to local Covid – 19 cases, it is important that all visitors use the QR code at our entrances to check in. I encourage all families to social distance and wear a mask while waiting to pick up your child/ren after school. As a school we are doing our best minimise the risk of a positive case onsite and we ask our community to do the same.

As we look forward to hopefully being able to hold whole school events towards the end of the year, please keep up to date via Compass. I will be receiving an updated Operations Guide in the coming days which will outline what it will look like for schools as restrictions lift.
