Using these texts, we have analysed various aspects including: word choice, sentence structure, illustrations, symbolism, inferences, connections and story lines.




By looking at these texts in both Reading and Writing, we have been able to write our own engaging Narratives with a focus on extended metaphors/ allegories.



#### Numeracy

In the first couple of weeks of Numeracy, we focused on various problem solving activities that were related to real life scenarios. Students learnt about the different types of strategies that can be used to help solve problems. Recently, we have been exploring Number and Place Value, delving into factors and multiples, rounding whole numbers and decimals and integers in everyday context.



# **Respectful Relationships**

Over the last few weeks we have spoken about positive and negative self-talk, strategies to cope with challenging times and how different people will rely on different coping strategies. There has been great classroom discussions around these strategies, with students learning the ways in which their peers cope.
