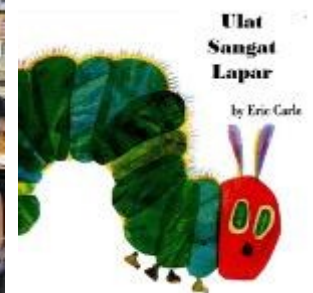
Selamat Datang (Welcome)
