
WHAT'S ON IN PREP?

Literacy:-

So far the Preps have enjoyed learning the names and sounds for the letters Ss, Tt, Ii, Aa, Nn, Pp and Hh. They have been practising writing them correctly in their books and are now recognising these letters as we read stories in class. They have also been looking for their Magic Words in texts and listening out for rhyming words.





Maths:-

The Preps have been busy practising counting every day. They are learning to count objects accurately up to 10 and match the number of objects with the

corresponding numeral. You can help by encouraging counting at home using objects around the house, e.g. fruit, toy cars, pencils etc.



Inquiry:-

This Term, the Preps have enjoyed learning about our school values: aim high, show respect, be organised and bounce forward. We have begun our unit on The Community, which has us thinking about how we make others feel and how we can fill their buckets. The word 'persistence' is now frequently used in prep as we have thought and drawn about some times that we showed persistence in our personal lives.
