

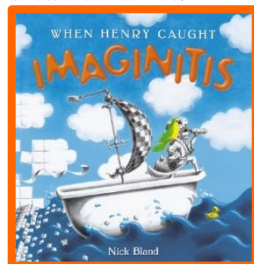
# What's On in Grade 3/4?

## Literacy

Towards the end of the Term, we began our mentor text 'When Henry Caught Imaginitis' by Nick Bland. A book that discusses the power and importance of unlocking our imagination. We learnt about Nick Bland's life as an Australian author. We have been working hard to analyse word choice, illustrations and sentence structures within this text. We have drawn inspiration from the book to use in our own narratives.



## Numeracy

We have recently completed our maths unit on Fractions. Students worked hard to model fractions as wholes and collections, as well as identify equivalent fractions. Students thoroughly enjoyed our problem-solving lesson where we worked to solve what fraction of water would enable students to achieve the best bottle flip.

We have just begun a new unit on Data. Students have been creating interesting questions and responses to collect data and then displaying their data using different types of



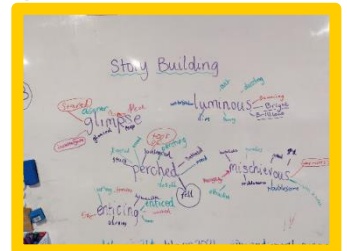
graphs.

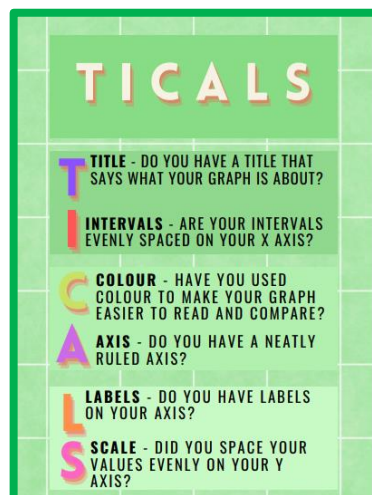


## Harvest Market
