From the Principal

Dear Families,

It is hard to believe that we are in the last week of Term One. It has been a challenging term for families navigating Covid infections and household close contacts. The communication to the office and classroom teachers from families when there has been positive infection has been amazing. This has allowed the school to be proactive and alert the community efficiently and effectively. At this stage, we have not received information from the Department of Education regarding the supply of rapid antigen tests in Term 2, however Wandin North will receive an additional 7 air purifiers at the end of the term break.

A huge thank you to the families and staff for their time and commitment to the Harvest Market that was on Sunday 20th of March. Once again, it was a terrific day that saw many members from the Wandin North Primary School and wider community in attendance. There were many highlights throughout the day that included great food, entertainment, the kids' activities with face painting, crazy hair, sand art all had long lines and the pre order produce boxes were big a hit. We do ask a lot from our parents and staff during Harvest Market, but I believe it is worth it in the end. It is a time where our community comes together for our only school fundraiser for the year. There is still money coming in from silent auction items but at the last count I am pleased to announce we raised just over \$39,000. The money raised will contribute to the leasing of digital technology devices as well as to our shade sail and assembly area upgrade. Thank you, thank you, thank you!

Many of you may have recently seen our local member Bridget Vallence discuss Wandin North Primary School's infrastructure in State Parliament. Over the last 2 years, school council have been building a case for Wandin North to have improved infrastructure in the form of permanent bricks and mortar buildings. Our objective is to provide the students with new and improved Library, Art and STEM spaces and classrooms that promote 21st century skills such as collaboration, creativity and critical thinking. Our teachers do an outstanding job to provide the high-quality educational experiences in our current portables. At Wandin North we strive to aim high and as a school council we will continue to build a strong narrative and advocate for our

students through constant correspondence with the Department of Education and State Government.

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I am excited to announce that the foundations for our shade sail are due to be constructed at the start of May and the sail installed mid-May. Our shade sail will cover the space where the veggie boxes are currently to form an outdoor classroom space. The tender process for the assembly area has been completed and I have been reassured by the VSBA that project will be completed by the end of the year. Fingers crossed.

This year we have continued our continuous reporting journey by going digital. During remote learning in 2020 and 2021, the feedback from parents was that they felt more connected to their child's learning by having an increased awareness of their child's learning capability and concepts being taught in the classroom. Our objective moving to continuous reporting via Compass is to keep the connection strong between school and home. I will be sending out a Google Form in the coming days to seek feedback from parents regarding our change to continuous reporting.

Mr Hallett and I have welcomed a lot of school tours this term and the calendar is starting to fill up to begin Term 2. Due to our built capacity, we will be capping our 2023 Prep enrolments; therefore, if you have a child that is commencing Prep at Wandin North, we would love completed enrolment forms with birth certificates and immunisation reports as soon as possible. This will help us have a true indication on how many new families we can accept in 2023. If you require an enrolment pack, they are available at the office or on our website.

We wish all our families a safe and enjoyable break.

FINANCE - FAMILY ACCOUNTS

CSEF / CREDIT ON ACCOUNTS - If you have a credit or unused CSEF (Camp, Sports and Excursion Funds) on your account, we please ask that this be used first, prior to paying for any additional event costings. Please be reminded that CSEF funds can't be used for School fees, Grade 6 graduation or School Uniforms. If you are unsure of the amount of credit or CSEF that you have, please email the school asking for a copy of your statement.

CSEF - Camps, Sports & Excursions Fund

CSEF ELIGIBILITY : Below are the criteria used to determine a student's eligibility for the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF).

<u>Criteria 1</u> – General eligibility To be eligible for the fund, a parent or carer of a student attending a registered Government or non-government Victorian primary or secondary school must:

• on the first day of Term one • on the first day of Term two

a) be a holder of one or more of the eligible financially-means tested cards OR be a temporary foster parent, and; b) submit an application to the school by the due date.

For the list of eligible financially-means tested cards refer to the CSEF Policy: https:// www2.education.vic.gov.au/pal/camps-sports-and-excursions-fund/policy

Parents who receive a Carer Allowance on behalf of a child, or any other benefit or allowance not income tested by Centrelink, are not eligible for the CSEF unless they also comply with the above. <u>Criteria 2</u> - Be of school age and attend school in Victoria For the purposes of CSEF, students may be eligible for assistance if they attend a Victorian registered primary or secondary school.

CSEF is not payable to students attending pre-school, kindergarten, home schooled, or TAFE. <u>Special Consideration</u> A special consideration category exists for § Families on a bridging visa, temporary protection visa, in community detention or are asylum seeker families § Students in

temporary out of home care arrangements, including statutory kinship care

For concession card holders CSEF eligibility will be subject to the parent/carer concession card being validated successfully with Centrelink on the first day of either term one (31 January 2022) or term two (26 April 2022). <u>PAYMENT AMOUNTS CSEF payment amount</u>

The CSEF is an annual payment to the school to be used towards camps, sports and/or excursion expenses for the benefit of the eligible student.

• Primary school student rate: \$125 per year. • Secondary school student rate: \$225 per year. The CSEF is paid directly to your child's school and will be allocated by the school towards camps, sports and/or excursion costs for your child.

For ungraded students, the rate payable is determined by the student's date of birth.

HOW TO COMPLETE THE APPLICATION FORM NOTE: ALL SECTIONS MUST BE COMPLETED BY PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN

1. Complete the PARENT/CARER DETAILS section. Make sure that the Surname, First Name, and Customer Reference Number (CRN) details match those on your concession card.

You will also need to provide your concession card to the school.

If you are claiming as a temporary Foster Parent or a Veteran Affairs Pensioner, you will need to provide a copy of documentation confirming your status as a temporary Foster Parent or provide your Veterans Affairs Pensioner Gold card to the school. If you are seeking special consideration, mark this in the form and provide a copy of the relevant documentation. 2. Complete the STUDENT/S DETAILS section for students at this school. 3. Sign and date the form and return it to the school office as soon as possible. **The CSEF program for 2022 closes on the 24 June 2022.**
