Readers Workshop

So far this Term, students have been beginning their Persuasive Unit, getting exposed to a number of texts and identifying the purpose of each text.



Grade 1

The students in Grade 1 have been looking at a variety of persuasive posters and focusing on the different accuracy strategies students can use to decode unknown words.

Grade 2

The students in Grade 2 have been exposed to a number of different forms of advertisements and looking at text evidence to determine who the target audience is and the purpose

In the coming weeks, both grades will be undertaking their Misty sequences with our Persuasive mentor text, Let's Save the Amazon.



Writers Workshop

Over the past couple of weeks, students have been immersed in our **Persuasive** unit.

Grade 1

The students have been exploring persuasive techniques using line debates, creating ideas and busily creating persuasive posters.

Grade 2

The students were working in small groups to create radio advertisements targeted towards parents or students about why they should come to Wandin North P.S. They have been learning to form opinions, develop reasons and learnt about devices such as slogans to persuade others.

This week, **Grade 1** students will commence their persuasive writing pieces and **Grade 2** students are creating persuasive posters based on an environmental issue.



Maths

Over the past weeks, students have been working very hard to develop their knowledge and understanding of **Place Value**.


Grade 1

Students have been focusing on creating two-digit numbers using concrete materials and investigating the numbers before and after.

Grade 2

Students learnt about the value of each digit in a given number and used this knowledge to make numbers, order numbers as well as identifying 1 more/1 less and 10 more/10 less.

This week, we begin our unit on **Addition and subtraction**.
