action-packed Term 3.



This Term students have been enjoying the work of Catherine Barr. For the remainder of the term the 1-2 Team will be using the wonderful text 'The Sea Swallow and the Humpback

Whale' by Catherine Barr. It is an informative text, sharing the challenges for Artic Tern's and a Northern Humpback Whale's encounter during their annual migration.





The **Grade 1s** continued to grow their understanding of numbers and using their knowledge to solve addition and subtraction problems. In Time, students increased their vocabulary and knowledge of telling time to the hour, half-hour and quarter hour. Students loved learning about number patterns, challenging themselves to find the how a pattern grows and changes. Currently students have been learning about <u>Money</u>. In particular counting and ordering small collections of coins.

The **Grade 2s** enjoyed learning about division, making sure items are shared equally. In Time, students increased their knowledge of how to tell time to the half hour and quarter hour. When graphing students learnt about the different types of graphs and how to read the data on them. Currently students are learning about Money and how to calculate change.
