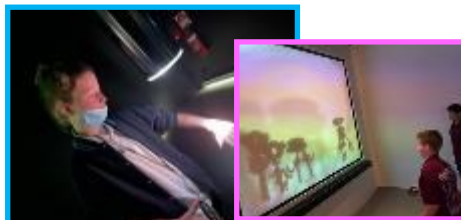
Art Club

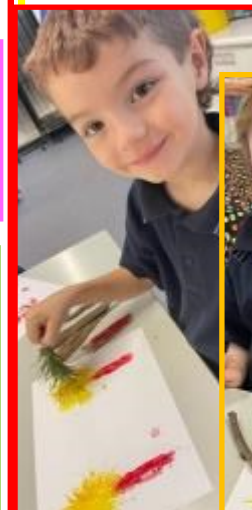
The LUME & ACMI
