Apa Kabar & Buah

Prep students have been busy learning about 'Apa Kabar?' (How Are You? feelings) and have practised greetings every lesson. They have also been getting familiar with names of fruits in Indonesian (buah). Students were excited to learn about exotic tropical fruits such as durian, manggis (mangosteen) and nangka (jackfruit).



Angka (Numbers)

Students in **Grade 1 and 2** have been practising their knowledge of Indonesian numbers. They have revised 0-10, and have extended to 11-20. The students have had fun engaging in number games such as Indonesian Bingo.



Binatang (Animals)

In Term 2, students in **Grade 3 and 4** learnt about animals that are found at the zoo. They focused on the text, 'Di Kebun Binatang' by Daniel Bradbury, and learnt to describe animals using colours and other adjectives. The students enjoyed discovering new facts about binatang Indonesia.



Timor Barat

Grade 5 and 6 students have focused on the text, 'Saya Anak Timor', another non-fiction story by Daniel Bradbury. They have viewed what a typical day involves for a young boy named Lui, who lives in a small village in Timor Barat (West Timor).
