LITERACY

In Reading, we have now learnt all the letters of the alphabet. We have begun learning about sounds that letters can make when we put them together.

We have also discovered the importance of choosing good fit books using I PICK. **P**urpose, **I**nterest, **C**omprehension, **K**now.

Soon we will be settled into our Reading rotation groups where students work through different activities during the week, focusing on a strategy.

In Writing, we have continued to focus on the foundation of writing including: capital letters, full stops, finger spaces, Magic Words and listening to the sounds in words. We have created some impressive pieces of writing about all different topics which has been really fun! We're more than happy to share our writing with you at any point, just come on in and have a look.

NUMERACY

In Numeracy, we have leant all about measurement. Beginning with heavier and lighter, full and empty, days of the week (in order), then we began to look at analogue clocks. We're quite good at making and reading o'clock times.

We have continued to count to 20 and beyond forward and backwards. Students are having lots of fun playing games with numbers where they need to work out

what comes before and after a given number.
