## *From the Principal*

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Dear Families,

We are very excited to have our School Library back up and running. All classes will visit the Library fortnightly on a Thursday and Friday. Our 2021 School Captain raised this issue with School Council last year. Over the Christmas break we put plans in the place to bring library back by constructing a wall to define the learning space. Our Education Support Staff have done a power of work cataloguing and contacting books. We encourage all students to bring a library bag to help facilitate take home borrowing.

Our Grade 3 and 5 students recently completed NAPLAN. Due to the lock downs of 2020, this was the first time for our Grade 5 students. The students completed it digitally for the first time and were amazing. All the students tried their very best we look forward to viewing the results when they arrive.

Thank you to the families who provided feedback on our shift to a continuous reporting model. Our objective as a school is to strengthen the connection between the school and home to allow parents to have an increased connection to what is being taught in the classroom and a greater understanding of your child's capabilities and next steps for their learning.

The portfolio tasks that are being sent home via Compass Chronicle are a snap shot. Students will be sitting additional mid-year assessments such as writing moderation, Fountas and Pinnell, Essential Assessments and VCAA on demand to inform both our progression points on reports and how we are working towards our 2022 targets for student outcomes.

Students will still receive a mid year report similarly to last year, with progression points against the Victorian Curriculum and a personal comment relating to your child's work habits, effort and areas on how you can best support your child at home.

There was a 'buzz' in the air which you only get when 100's of children are excitedly running from one activity to the next. The Art Show was amazing! A huge thank you to my staff for organising such a great night and to the cleaners for cleaning it up the following day!

Our 2023 enrolments are coming in and we encourage any interested families to submit their enrolment forms as soon as possible. Our transition visits commence in October and it is very helpful for our planning if we can confirm numbers for 2023.

I have been approached by many students over the past few weeks who are expressing an interest in running different 'clubs' for others to be involved in. Our school based clubs are ranging from 'basketball' 'origami' to 'sports'. All of the leaders are students and EVERYONE is invited to join in a lunchtime activity. I love the proactivity and organisation these students are displaying and I'd also like to thank staff who are assisting with these groups in their own time.

Recently, I have been in discussions with the Victorian Schools Building Authority relating to the upgrades to our assembly area. In 2020, yes 2020, we received a grant to provide an all-weather shelter and resurface the area with synthetic turf. I have been assured by the VSBA that this project will be completed by the end of this year. It is exciting to the path works have started along Warburton Highway. This has been a long time coming. It is scheduled to be completed by July weather pending.

## Working With Children Checks (WWCC) And Code Of Conduct

**All volunteers helping in our school require a valid Working With Children Check.**

If you have recently received your WWCC card, remember to bring it to the office for registration.

Should you already hold a WWCC card for another organisation you will not be required to apply for a new card, however you will need to advise the Department of Justice that you are now a volunteer at Wandin North Primary School. Please provide a copy of your card to the school office. We also require you to complete a 'Code Of Conduct' form.

This year, many existing WWCC's will be due for renewal. The expiry date is clearly marked on the front and back of your card. A renewal form will be posted to you by the Department of Justice approximately eight weeks before your card expires.
