Noteworthy:

- RAPID ANTIGEN TESTS: The Victorian Government is providing up to three further deliveries of Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs) in Term 3 and again in Term 4 to schools. These should be distributed by schools for use by staff and students who are symptomatic or who are household contacts. All schools will receive the first delivery of Term 3 RATs by the end of week 3.
 - All students will receive a Rapid Antigen Test upon the delivery to the school. If you require a RAT before this time, please contact the school.
