From the Principal

Dear Families,

It is hard to believe that we are halfway through the 2022 year! Our Preps are very excited to celebrate 100 days of school this Friday. We welcome parents and extended family members to attend and participate in the celebration. Yesterday Prep S had their Prep Share Time, and it was fantastic to see the students beaming with pride as they shared their published writing pieces with their parents and family members. I was lucky to be a part of it and see the growth the students had demonstrated from the beginning of the year to now. It was outstanding! Prep A's Share Time is today at 3:00pm and both Prep grades will be sharing again on Wednesday morning. Its going to be a big week in Prep!

On Friday the 29th of July we held our first kinder kids story time. We had a great number in attendance. The kinder kids were amazing, they settled into the Miss Abbruzzese's room, listened beautifully and had several great questions. The Grade 5 students who then buddied up with a kinder kid demonstrated terrific leadership when reading Pig the Pug. There were plenty of smiles. Our next kinder kid story time is Friday 12th of August. The invitation is to all kinder children and parents.

A reminder the 2023 enrolment forms are due to the Office by Friday 12th August. We still have limited places available. If there are current or prospective families interested in enrolling their child at Wandin North in 2023 feel free to call the school for more information.

In Semester One we a had a high number of unexplained absences which lead to changes to our practices. The changes have been warmly received and our unexplained absences number to begin the second half of the year have been very minimal. A reminder that if your child is going to be away, an absent note on Compass is required.

I was very proud to receive the results from the Department of Education's Attitude to School Survey (AtoSS). Students in years 4 – 6 complete the survey each year. The survey provides schools with data relating to how the children feel about school, themselves as a learner, connection to peers and their own mental health and wellbeing. As a school, we improved in all areas with the standout areas being connectedness to peers (92% positive responses), teacher effectiveness (91% positive responses) and learning confidence (90% positive responses). We will be using the data from the AtoSS to evaluate our practices to ensure our students feel safe and secure with their peers, teachers and learning.

Lunch clubs have continued to be a success. Our Art captains did a great job organising and presenting awards for the holiday art competition. I am excited to announce that our Indonesian captains will be starting a lunch club from today for the Prep – 2 students and 3-6 students next week. Children are welcome to go to the Indonesian room on Tuesdays and the Art room on Wednesdays from 11:10am to 11:30am.

It looks like the path along Warburton Highway is nearing completion. This has been a long time coming and I know there has been a number of the Wandin North PS community members who have applied pressure to council over the years for the path to be constructed and allow the children to cross the highway and walk safely to bus stop or pick up points on Victoria Road. The new path will provide another safe option for parents to pick up their children from.

Compass: Absence Notifications

All student absences must be explained by parents using Compass. Parents are asked to please ensure that the <u>correct time date and time</u> frame is selected when sending absence notifications.

Compass has two sessions: AM (9:00am – 12:00pm) and PM (12:30pm – 3:30pm). Please be careful with selecting the appropriate dates and times for the duration of your child's absence.



Compass: Late Arrivals & Early Departures

All students must be signed in and out by parents at the office using the Compass 'Kiosk' (iPad). This will time stamp your child's arrival/departure on grade rolls.

Late students need to obtain a 'Late Pass' upon arrival. Students being collected early will be called to the office by staff where they will be collected by parents/carers. Parents are not to go directly to the classroom unless requested by staff.

Please ensure that to sanitise your hands before using the Compass iPad to sign in/out your children.

Child Safe

Wandin North Primary School is commitment to creating and maintaining a child safe organisation where children and young people are safe and feel safe. Our Code Of Conduct and Child Safe policies can be found on the school's website.

Working With Children Checks (WWCC) <u>And</u> Code Of Conduct

All volunteers helping in our school require a valid Working With Children Check.

If you have recently received your WWCC card, remember to bring it to the office for registration.

Should you already hold a WWCC card for another organisation you will not be required to apply for a new card, however you will need to advise the Department of Justice that you are now a volunteer at Wandin North Primary School. Please provide a copy of your card to the school office. We also require you to complete a 'Code Of Conduct' form.

This year, many existing WWCC's will be due for renewal. The expiry date is clearly marked on the front and back of your card. A renewal form will be posted to you by the Department of Justice approximately eight weeks before your card expires. Applications must be made online at http://www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au/home/applications/

We also require you to complete a 'Code Of Conduct' form before you are able to assist with activities. If you have not yet done so, please collect a form from the office staff.
