2023 Curriculum Contributions

A message was posted on Compass yesterday stating that School Council are pleased to advise that the 2023 Curriculum Contributions (previously referred to as School Fees) are now open for payment via Compass.

The 2023 Curriculum Contribution is \$300 per student.

A friendly reminder that the Curriculum Contributions covers all your students book packs, stationary, digital devices and programs for the devices, materials for Art, Sustainability, LOTE, Health & PE etc. The Curriculum Contributions do not cover camps, incursions and excursions. These are additional costs and will be advised upon activities being organised throughout 2023 but your child's teacher. We would greatly appreciate payment of Curriculum Contributions PRIOR to the start of Term 1, 2023. Please contact the school office if you have any queries.

2023 CSEF

Please be reminded that if you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for the 2023 CSEF (Camps, Sports, Excursions Funds). A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

The 2023 Application forms should be available shortly from DET, which we will then advise you via the school newsletter / weekly news when you can submit your application. Cards must be valid on the first day of Term 1, 2023.

Compass: Absence Notifications

All student absences must be explained by parents using Compass. Parents are asked to please ensure that the correct time date

and time frame is selected when sending absence notifications.

Compass has two sessions : AM (9:00am - 12:00pm) and PM (12:30pm - 3:30pm). Please be careful with selecting the appropriate dates and times for the duration of your child's absence.

Notifications will be sent daily to parents at 9:30am for unexplained absences and will then be followed up by a phone call from the school.



Compass: Late Arrivals & Early Departures

All students must be signed in and out by parents at the office using the Compass 'Kiosk' (iPad). This will time stamp your child's arrival/departure on grade rolls.

Late students need to obtain a 'Late Pass' upon arrival. Students being collected early will be called to the office by staff where they will be collected by parents/carers. Parents are not to go directly to the classroom unless requested by staff.

Please ensure that to sanitise your hands before using the Compass iPad to sign in/out your children.

Working With Children Checks (WWCC) <u>And</u> Code Of Conduct

All volunteers helping in our school require a valid Working With Children Check.

If you have recently received your WWCC card, remember to bring it to the office for registration.

Should you already hold a WWCC card for another organisation you will not be required to apply for a new card, however you will need to advise the Department of Justice that you are now a volunteer at Wandin North Primary School. Please provide a copy of your card to the school office. We also require you to complete a 'Code Of Conduct' form.

This year, many existing WWCC's will be due for renewal. The expiry date is clearly marked on the front and back of your card. A renewal form will be posted to you by the Department of Justice approximately eight weeks before your card expires. We also require you to complete a 'Code Of Conduct' form before you are able to assist with activities. If you have not yet done so, please collect a form from the office staff.
