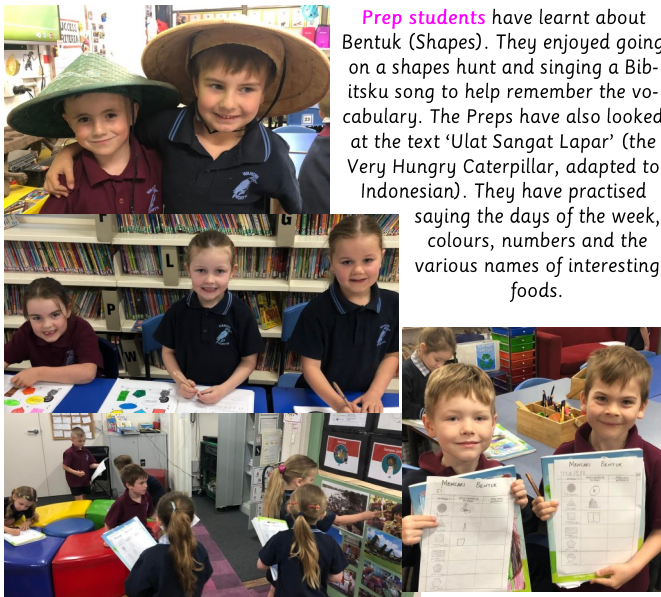


# WHAT'S ON IN INDONESIAN

## End of Year Snapshot

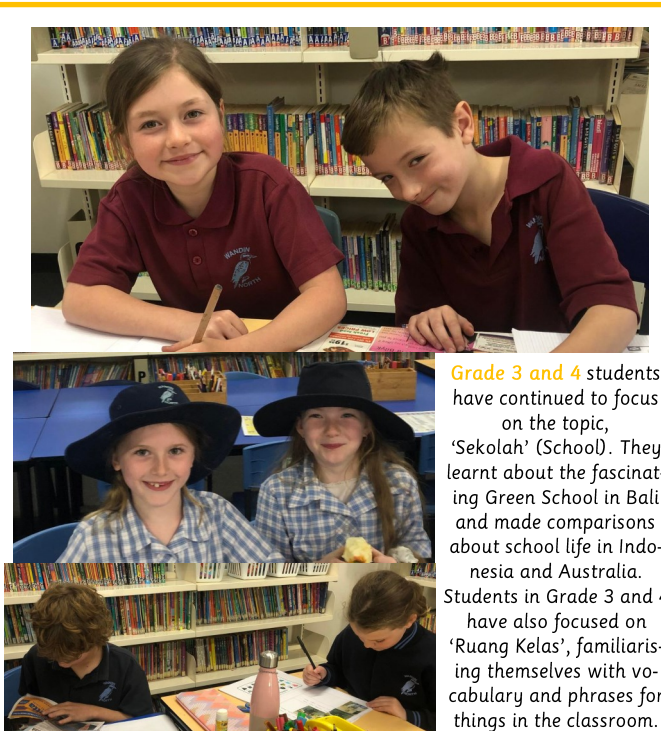

Here is what we have recently been up to in Indonesian:



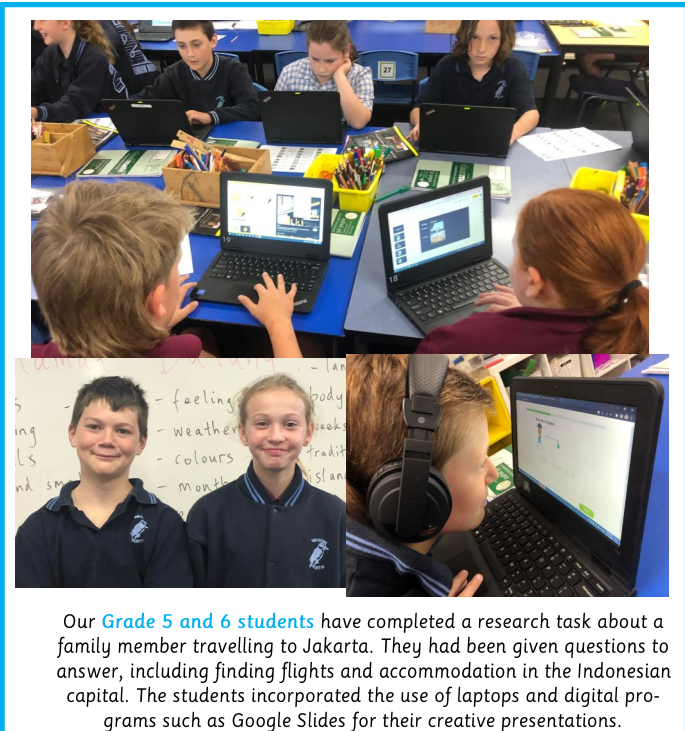
**Prep students** have learnt about Bentuk (Shapes). They enjoyed going on a shapes hunt and singing a Bibitku song to help remember the vocabulary. The Preps have also looked at the text 'Ulat Sangat Lapar' (the Very Hungry Caterpillar, adapted to Indonesian). They have practised saying the days of the week, colours, numbers and the various names of interesting foods.



Students in **Grade 1 and 2** have focused on hobbies and sports. They have sorted interests and grouped them into personal 'Saya suka' (likes) and 'Saya tidak suka' (dislikes) graphs.



**Grade 3 and 4** students have continued to focus on the topic, 'Sekolah' (School). They learnt about the fascinating Green School in Bali and made comparisons about school life in Indonesia and Australia. Students in Grade 3 and 4 have also focused on 'Ruang Kelas', familiarising themselves with vocabulary and phrases for things in the classroom.



Our **Grade 5 and 6** students have completed a research task about a family member travelling to Jakarta. They had been given questions to answer, including finding flights and accommodation in the Indonesian capital. The students incorporated the use of laptops and digital programs such as Google Slides for their creative presentations.
