This year, the names in blue font on the roster are either new families or current families that have been reallocated due to the reduced number of working bees scheduled in 2023.

Each family is required to attend only once throughout the year, to help maintain and further improve our school grounds. Each month a list of jobs is assigned to the nominated group. A message will be posted on Compass leading up to the working bee.

A School Council member will be in charge of their 'crew' and will direct jobs for the morning (9:00am – 12:00pm).

Tasks may include minor works jobs such as plumbing, concreting, painting, mulching, cleaning, paving, gardening etc. Materials for approved tasks will be purchased by the school.

If you are unable to attend on your allocated day, please contact the school so that a more suitable day can be arranged.

Remember – this is only one day (3 hours) per year.

The work carried out by parents saves the school enormous costs by not having to officially employ a regular gardener or handyman. The school buildings and grounds always require care and attention. It is important that we keep up with these demands. In doing so, the children and teachers all appreciate working in a clean, safe and aesthetically pleasing environment.
