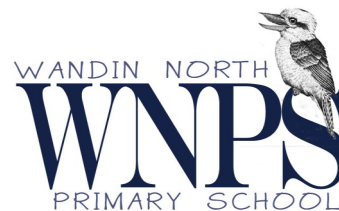

- ♦ **WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK & CODE OF CONDUCT :** All volunteers helping in our school must have a current, valid Working With Children Check. Applications must be made online at <http://www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au/home/applications/>

We also require you to complete a 'Code Of Conduct' form before you are able to assist with activities. If you have not yet done so, please collect a form from the office staff.

- ♦ **CHILD SAFE :** Wandin North Primary School is commitment to creating and maintaining a child safe organisation where children and young people are safe and feel safe. Our Code of Conduct and Child Safe policies can be found on the school's website.

- ◆ **2024 PREP ENROLMENTS** : We request that parents with children starting school in 2024 notify the office and submit an enrolment form as soon as possible. This will greatly assist us with ensuring you receive important information relating to your child's transition to school.



- ◆ **COMPASS - ABSENCE NOTIFICATIONS** : All student absences must be explained by parents using Compass. Parents are asked to please ensure that the correct time date and time frame is selected when sending absence notifications. Compass has two sessions : AM (9:00am – 12:00pm) and PM (12:30pm – 3:30pm). Please be careful with selecting the appropriate dates and times for the duration of your child's absence.

- ◆ **NO NUTS PLEASE** : Some children at this school are allergic to nuts. We urge you to refrain from sending food containing nuts to school.



- ◆ **SUN SMART POLICY** : Reminder - School hats are to be worn outside for Term 1 and Term 4 as part of our Sun Smart Policy.



- ◆ **NO SMOKING** : Smoking is NOT PERMITTED at any time on school grounds or the surrounding areas, including the car parks.

- ◆ **CAMPS/ SPORTS / EXCURSIONS FUNDS (CSEF)** : Eligible families are reminded that applications for CSEF are now open. Please ensure you read the following information and visit the school office with a copy of your current card, and complete the CSEF application form which is available at the office.

Eligibility Date For concession card holders CSEF eligibility will be subject to the parent/carer concession card being validated successfully with Centrelink on the first day of either term one (30 January 2023) or term two (24 April 2023).

Payment Amounts The CSEF is an annual payment to the school to be used towards camps, sports and/or excursion expenses for the benefit of the eligible student • Primary school student rate: \$125 per year. The CSEF is paid directly to your child's school and will be allocated by the school towards camps, sports and/or excursion costs for your child. Please visit the school office for a form. When completing the form, ALL SECTIONS MUST BE COMPLETED BY PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN

1. Complete the PARENT/CARER DETAILS section. Make sure that the Surname, First Name, and Customer Reference Number (CRN) details match those on your concession card. You will also need to provide your concession card to the school.

If you are claiming as a temporary Foster Parent or a Veteran Affairs Pensioner, you will need to provide a copy of documentation confirming your status as a temporary Foster Parent or provide your Veterans Affairs Pensioner Gold card to the school. If you are seeking special consideration, mark this in the form and provide a copy of the relevant documentation.

2. Complete the STUDENT/S DETAILS section for students at this school.

3. Sign and date the form and return it to the school office as soon as possible.

The CSEF program for 2023 closes on the 23 June 2023.
