

To support our Narrative unit this Term, students have enjoyed reading 'The Gruffalo' By Julia Donaldson. Students used the text to learn about Determining Importance in a fiction text. They focused on understanding the story then finding which parts are important and which are just interesting.



To finish off the Term, students focussed on Questioning using the wordless book 'Window' by Jeannie Baker. They looked at what makes a good question and how to ask questions to the author.

Maths

We started the month off learning about Fractions. Students cut up shapes to find halves, guarters and eights then used this skill to find fractions of a collection. Our next topic was Chance! Students explored the vocabulary. They conducted experiments with coloured blocks and spinners to find the probability and



possible and total outcomes. Currently we are learning about Location & Transformation. Students have been using the vocabulary to guide their partners around the room to specific objects.

Our first topic in Term 2 is Place Value.

This Term our Inquiry Unit has been all about 'In Our Community'. Students have been learning about our community and

the different emergency services. We learnt about situations that might require us to call 000 and also what to do if we are lost or injured. Students loved our visits from St Johns
