
READING & WRITING

We have been focusing on author's purpose. Using the acronym PIE, students have been analysing a range of texts and deciding whether they have been written to persuade, inform or entertain. Students have found that many texts are actually multi-genre and have often been written for more than one purpose. In reading, students have been enjoying working in groups to expand their comprehension capabilities together before applying what they have learnt while reading their own books.

Students have been using their knowledge of author's purpose to start writing amazing persuasive pieces. We have been learning about all the different persuasive techniques we can use to make our arguments stronger. Some topics include; why we should adopt pets, stopping pollution, making contact with alien life, and playing sports.







NUMERACY

In maths we have continued looking at fractions, decimals and percentages. Students have learnt how to convert back and forth, from fraction to decimal to percentage. We have also begun adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing these numbers. Students used their multiplication knowledge to work out measurements of areas within the school grounds.



INQUIRY

Students have continued to explore democracy and how the Australian government works. We have investigated the roles of leaders and followers, and have looked at how laws are made and enforced.
