LITERACY

This Term, we have continued with Readers and Writers Workshop. We are independently reading for 15 minutes each day and are sharing our thinking. We have learnt several reading strategies including: Characters emotions and how they have changed throughout a text, text features of a book and analysing the text.

In Writing, we have all been working very hard while exploring some new genres. We have been using our imaginations to write creative stories where we have begun to extend our thinking and ideas. Last week, we started working on our Informational Reports where we researched and wrote facts about animals.

NUMERACY

In Numeracy, we have continued to practise counting forwards to 100 and backwards from various starting points. Some of us have even been challenging ourselves to count by 10s, 5s and 2s to 100.

We are all experts in Location. We have had so much fun using words to describe where things are using words such as **in**, **on**, **between** and **below**.

We had lots of fun describing, recognising and ordering Australian coins according to their values. In prep we love challenges so we have all had a go at making the value of a coin in different ways. For example: 20c can be made by two cent coins, four 5c coins, one 10c coin and two 5c coins.

INQUIRY

In Prep, the children have been learning about Living Things. We are learning so much about animals that have: Feathers, Fur, Scales and Skin. We were all very excited to get a visit from Reptile



Encounter. They came to talk to us about different types of animals. We saw a baby snake, huge snake, turtle, frogs, a lizard and even a baby crocodile.

Book Week:
