Dear Parents/Guardians,

We have had an action-packed month in August with a lot of learning, celebrating student achievements and lots of extra-curricular events across the school.

Book week was a great success! It started on the Monday where all classes participated in an online book author experience. We were so lucky with the weather to be able to have a whole school parade on the basketball before assembly.

To continue on the Literacy theme, we celebrated our wonderful authors.
