- ◆ **2026 Camps / Sports / Excursion Funds (CSEF) application forms are now available.**  
The 2026 CSEF application forms are now available for eligible parents to complete. Please note it is the responsibility of the family to determine if they are a health care card holder and are eligible. The school is not privy to any families personal financials, so are unable to contact parents / carers direct to remind them of the applications being open.  
Please ensure that forms are back to the school office together with a copy of your valid health care card, ideally by **15th February 2026**, to allow adequate time for the funds to come in so they can be used on your child/ren activities, as soon as events happen in 2026.  
General eligibility is as follows:  
The applicant must be one of the following:
  - a parent or carer who is the beneficiary of a financially means-tested card.
  - a student over 16 years who is considered a mature minor and holds a valid concession card (such as a Youth Allowance Health Care Card or Disability Support Pension Card).
 For guidance on assessing whether a student is a mature minor, refer to the department's policy on Mature Minors and Decision Making.
