- ◆ **School Start Time - 9:00am** : Our school day begins at 9:00am. There are two minutes of music at 8:58am to alert students to line up with their class. The attendance roll is taken at the start of the day. Please remind your children to listen for the music and immediately make their way to their class to avoid being marked absent. Students arriving after the 9:00am bell are required to be signed in on the Compass Kiosk at the office. This will update the roll and time stamp their arrival. Students also need to collect a Late Pass to give their teacher.

◆ 2027 Prep Enrolments : Student Insight Digital Enrolment - Now Open!
